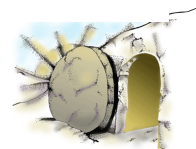

What do you know about nuts?

Nuts are high in fats and calories but do you know they offer significant health benefits. For instance:

Walnuts lower breast cancer risk in animal studies.

Almonds reduce insulin resistance and LDL cholesterol.

Sunflower seeds lowers LDL cholesterol.

Pistachios may help reduce lung cancer risk; improves "good" HDL cholesterol.

Peanuts help control type 2 diabetes by helping to reduce blood glucose and, also, reduce LDL "bad" cholesterol.

Pecans lower LDL cholesterol.

Macadamia nuts lower LDL cholesterol.

Nuts help your meals satisfy you a little longer but don't eat too many. Stick to a daily serving – enough to fill only the palm of your hand.

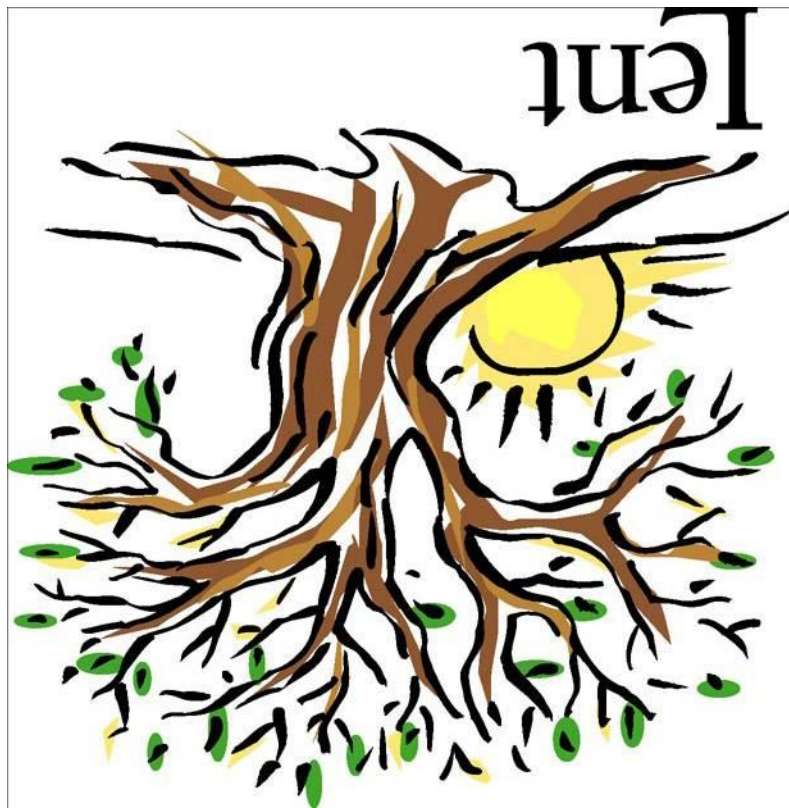
